

Bouncy Castles

St Anne's Catholic Church, Buxton Church Premises Booking Terms & Conditions

Bouncy castles – Bouncy castles and other inflatable equipment may only be used by pre-approval at the time of booking. The hirer must ensure that any inflatable play equipment that they have hired has been certified and inspected under the appropriate inspection scheme; Pertexa Inflatable Play Accreditation (<https://www.pipa.org.uk/>) or Amusement Device Inspection Procedures Scheme (<http://www.adips.co.uk/>). You must ensure copies of relevant certification are immediately available on request.

Special attention must be given to the location of the inflatable and its proximity to an available power supply. Coiled extension leads, worn flexes and items with guards which do not meet current British Standards are not acceptable. Extension leads must be used with caution and if used, must be safely secured so as not to cause a trip hazard.

The PPC reserves the right to refuse permission for any inflatable play equipment deemed to be unsuitable for the venue.

You are responsible for all safety aspects of any inflatable/equipment hired/used prior to, during or subsequent to the event, and must accept liability for any loss, damage, injury or death howsoever and by whomsoever caused, whether to property or person(s) sustained by any person(s) on the premises, which may be attributable to any act or omission on the part of the Hirer, inflatable/equipment operator/owner, guests or visitors.

You must ensure that that any inflatable/equipment operator/owner has

adequate Public Liability cover up to £5 million.
